Reproductive Health (RH) Program

The Reproductive Health (RH) Program provides services to individuals regardless of their race, color, national origin, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, age, disability <u>or immigration status.</u> It covers reproductive health services such as contraceptives (birth control, condoms), emergency contraception (Plan B), screenings for sexually transmitted infections, pregnancy testing, permanent contraception (tubals, vascectomies), well-woman visits to prevent health problems and abortion. Full OHP coverage for women enrolled in CAWEM+ for 60 days after giving birth. *Starting January 1, 2019, those with private health insurance will have access to reproductive health and related preventative services with no cost sharing.*
