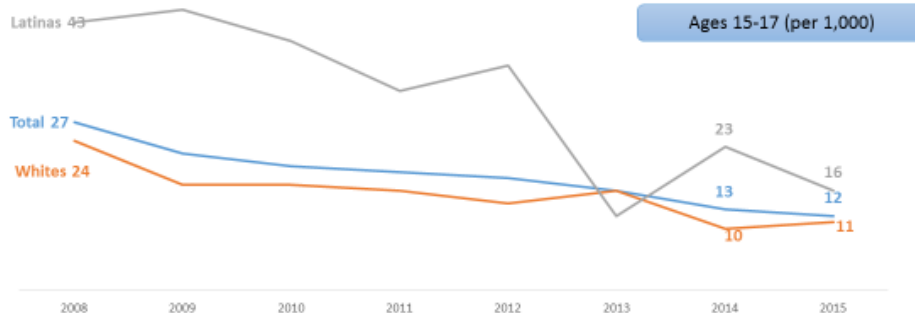

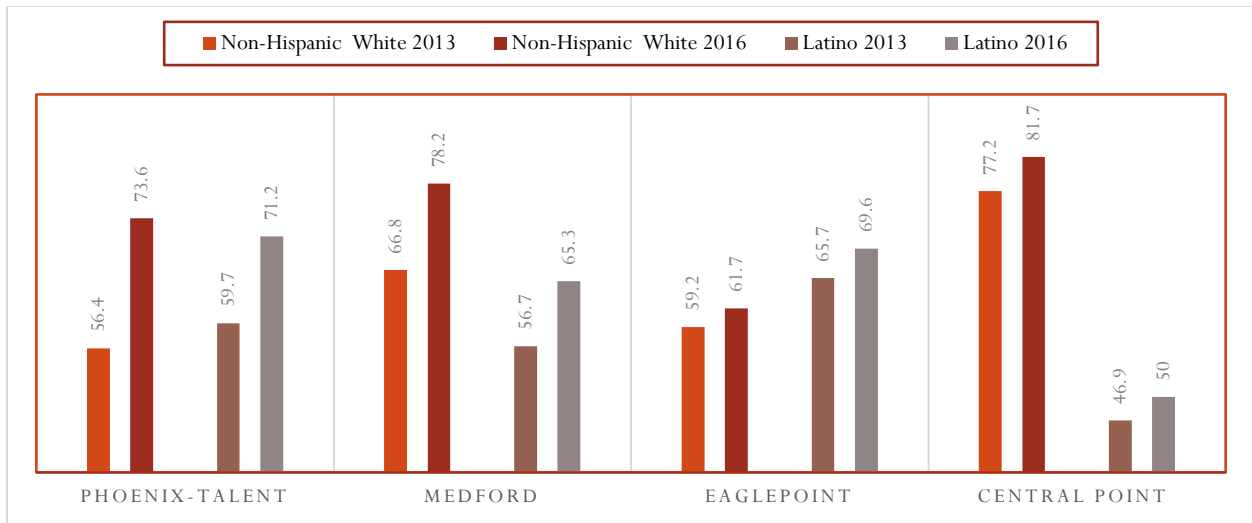
Jackson County teen pregnancy rates for ages 15-17 have declined for all groups since 2008 and the gap between non-Hispanic whites and Latinas is narrowing.

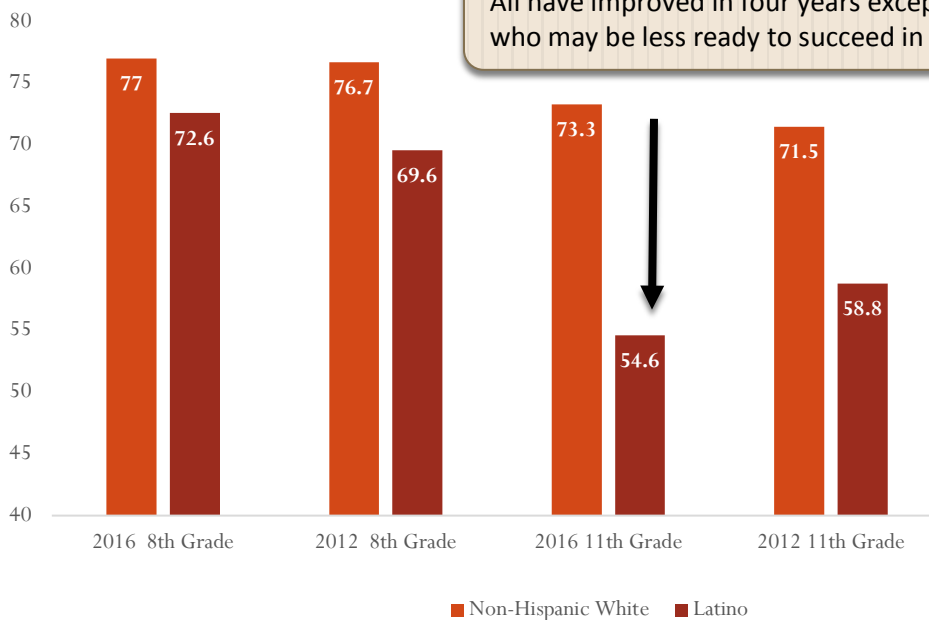
### On Time Graduation from High School 2013 and 2016

### Percentage of Students in Jackson County Getting Good Grades

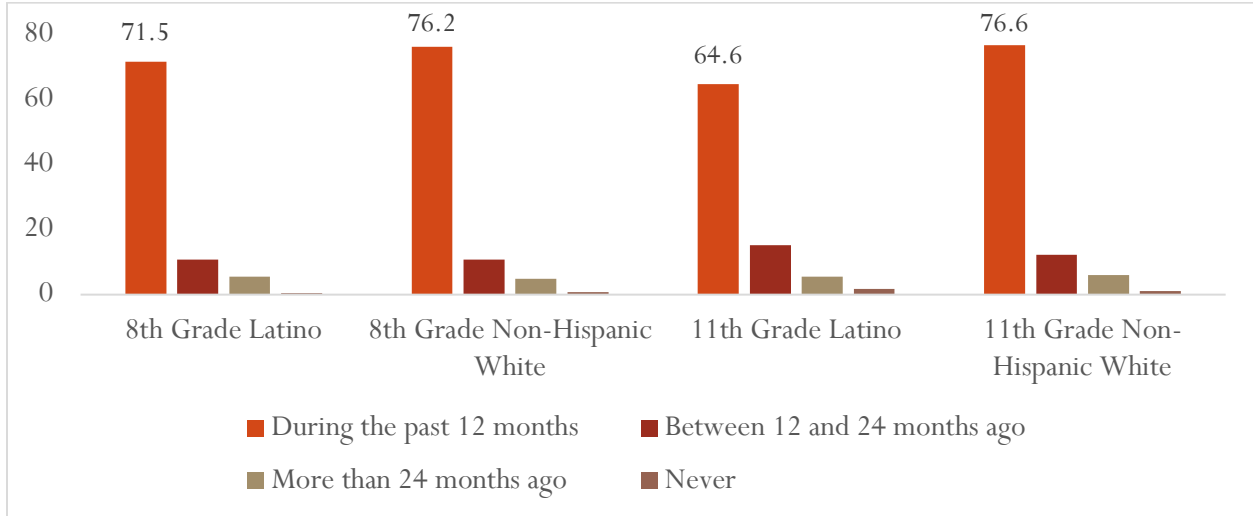


All have improved in four years except Latino 11<sup>th</sup> Graders who may be less ready to succeed in college

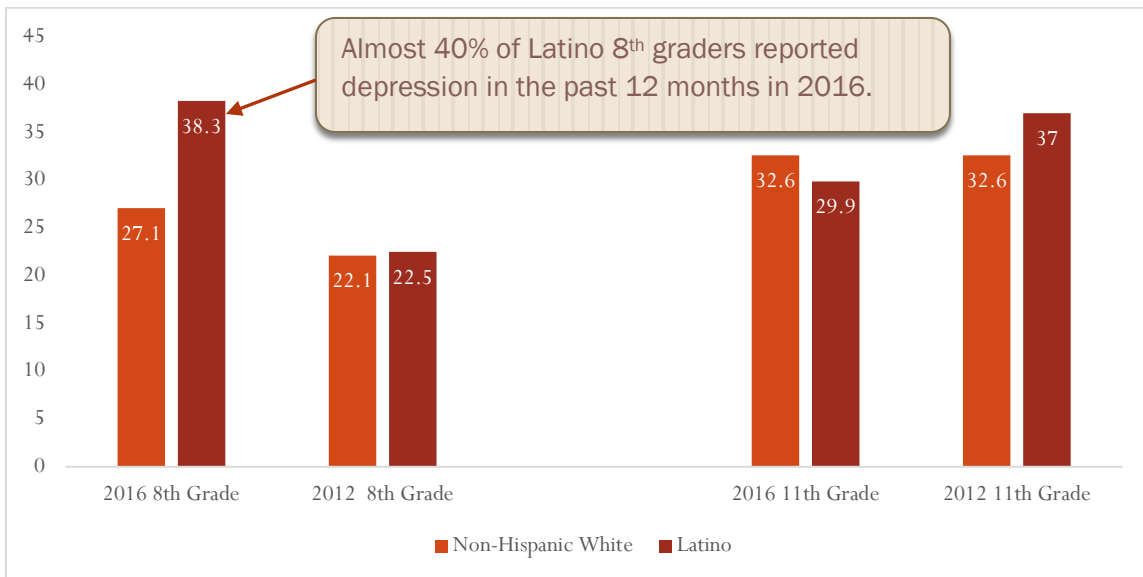
**When did you last go to a dentist or dental hygienist for a check-up, exam, teeth cleaning, or other dental work?**

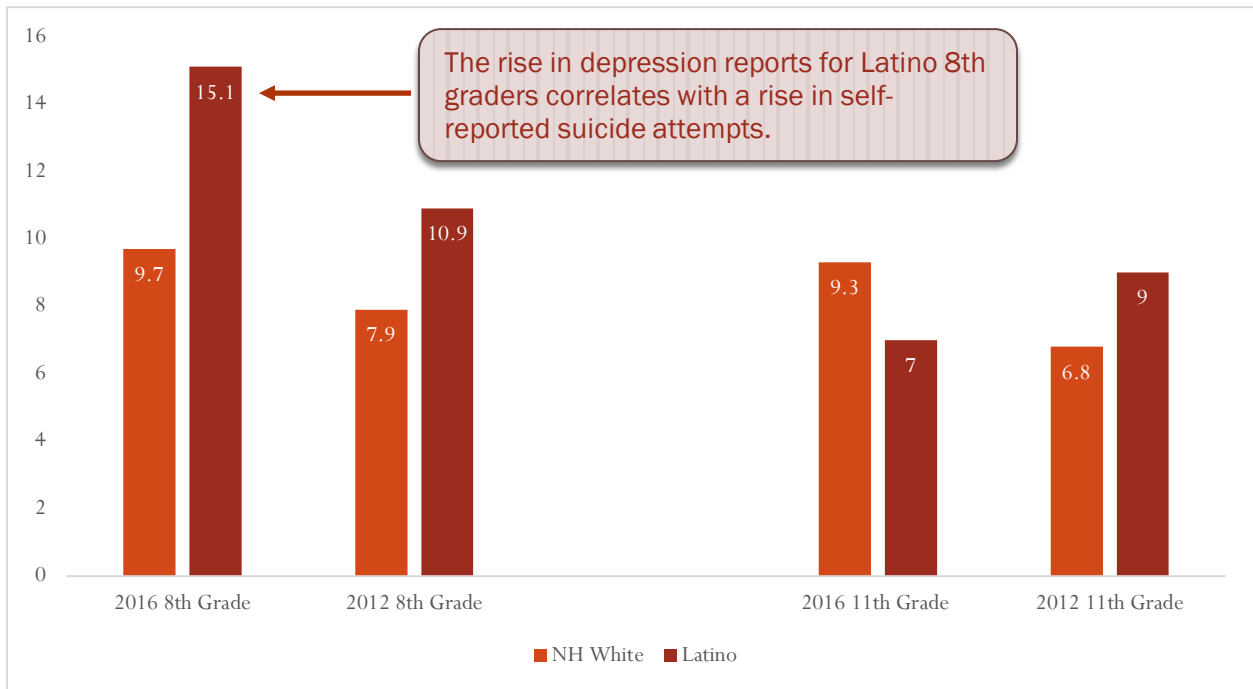
**Health Status – Depression and Suicide**

**During the past 12 months, did you ever feel so sad or hopeless almost every day for two weeks or more in a row that you stopped doing some usual activities?**



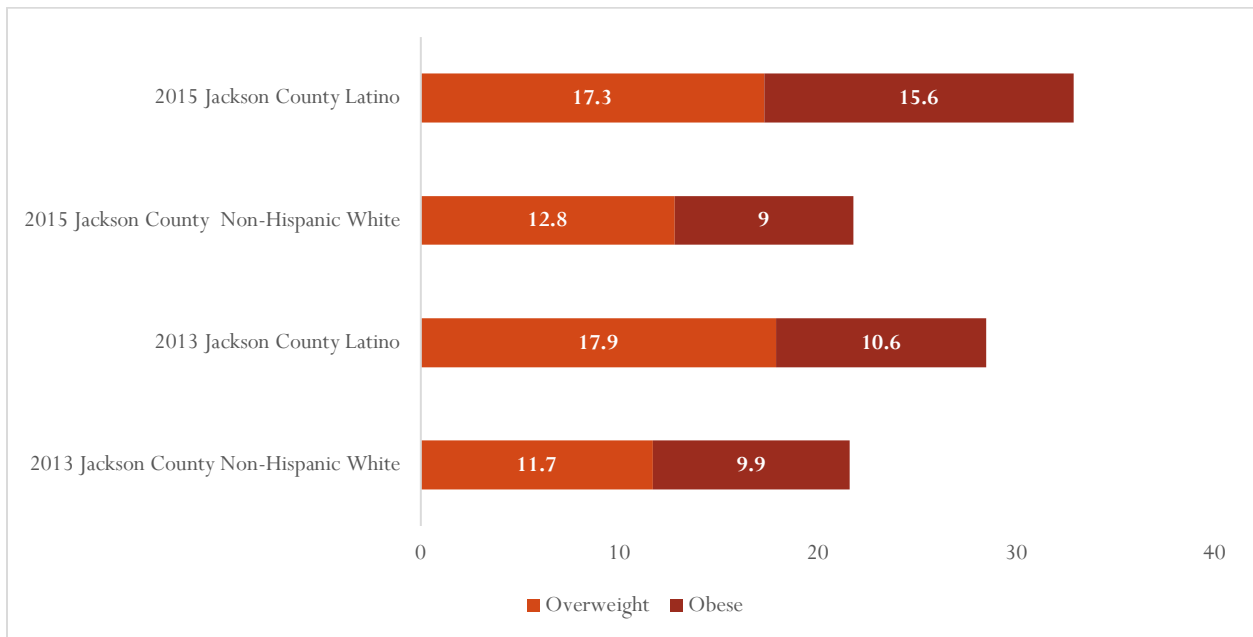

## Health Status – Weight



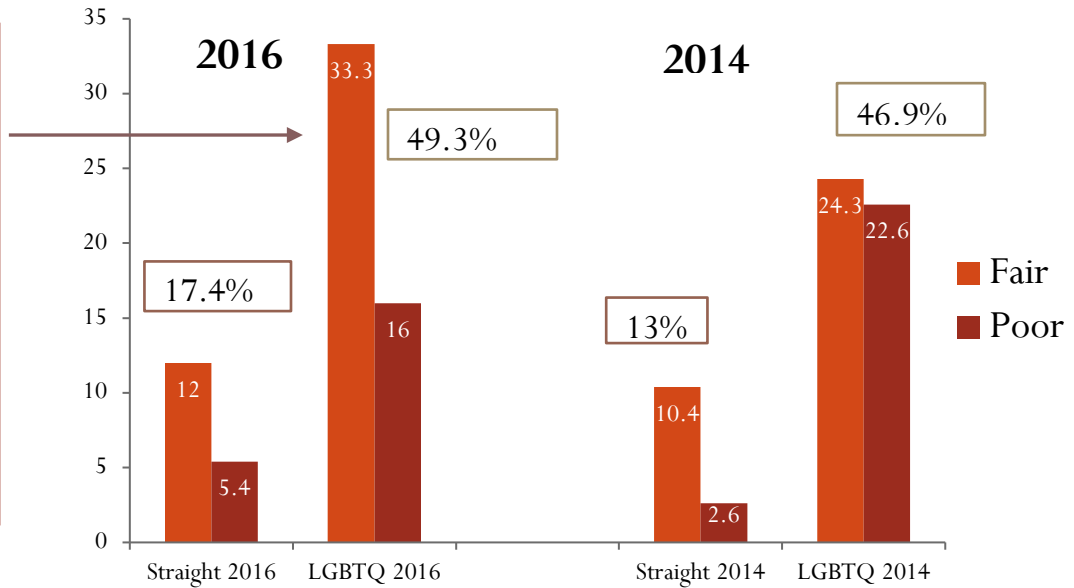
In 2015, 32.9% of Latino 8<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> Graders were overweight or obese compared to 21.8% of Non-Hispanic White students. Obesity rates rose 5% for Latino youth between 2013 and 2015. Source: Oregon Healthy Teens Survey 2013 and 2015

## Data on Health Status Related to Sexual Orientation

The percentage of Jackson County 11<sup>th</sup> graders reporting they describe themselves as Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender or Queer (LGBTQ) doubled from 10.3% in 2014 to 21.1% in 2016. 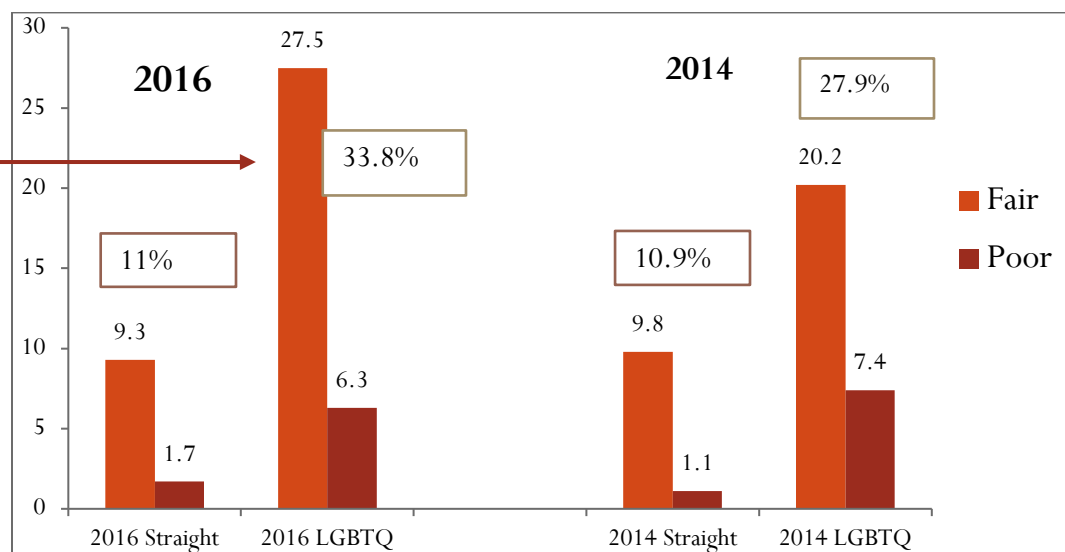
### Would you say that in general your emotional- mental health is:

Half of LGBTQ 11 graders in Jackson County report fair or poor mental health in 2016

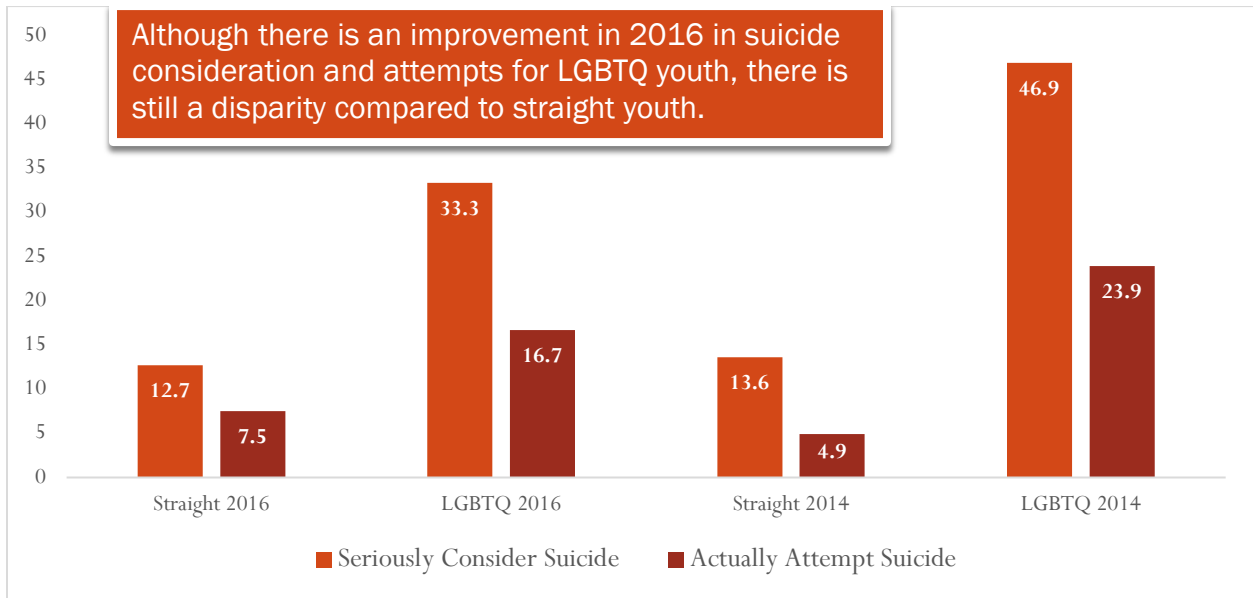


### Would you say that in general your physical health is:

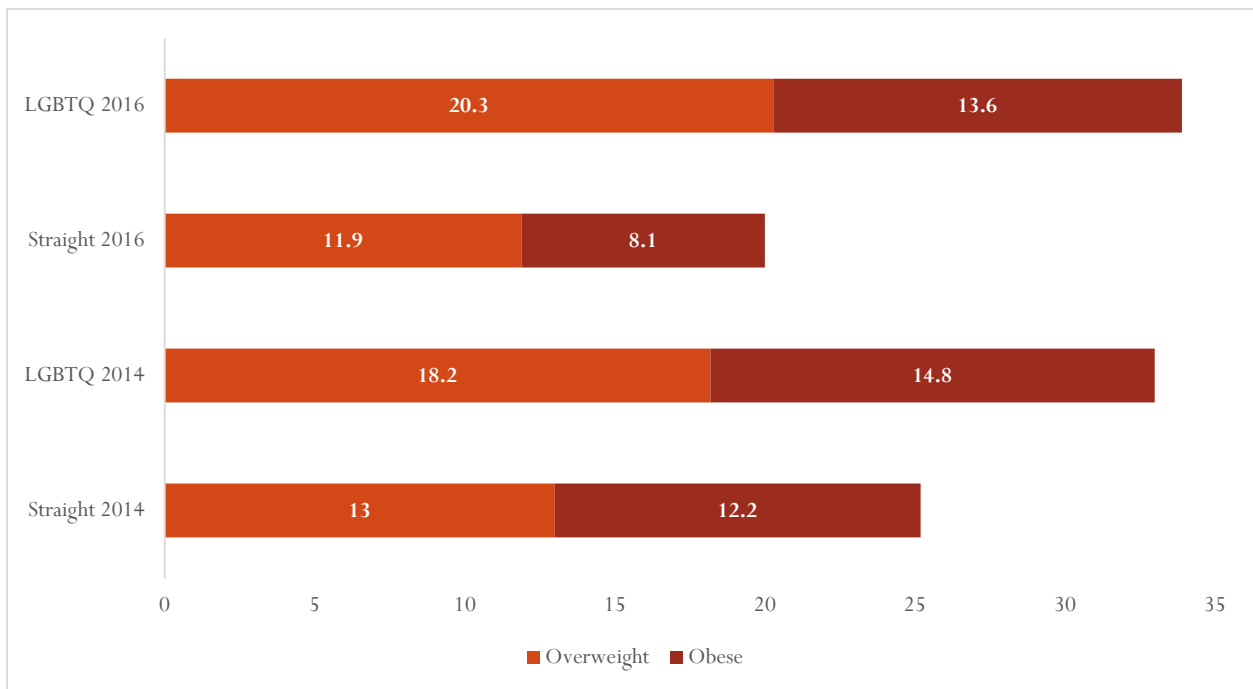
A third of Jackson County 11<sup>th</sup> grade LGBTQ youth report fair or poor physical health

## Percentage of Overweight and Obese Youth 11<sup>th</sup> Graders



In 2016, 33.9% of LGBTQ 11<sup>th</sup> graders in Jackson County were overweight or obese compared to 20% of straight youth. This pattern is worse in 2016 than in 2014.
