***If you have health insurance, they MUST cover ALL birth control methods at NO COST to you. Regardless of your insurance status, you may still qualify for free or low cost birth control under the RH program or CCARE, please see guidelines below.***

### Reproductive Health (RH) Program

The Reproductive Health (RH) Program provides services to individuals regardless of their race, color, national origin, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, age, disability or immigration status. It covers reproductive health services such as contraceptives (birth control, condoms), emergency contraception (Plan B), screenings for sexually transmitted infections, pregnancy testing, permanent contraception (tubals, vasectomies), well-woman visits to prevent health problems and abortion. Full OHP coverage for women enrolled in CAWEM+ for 60 days after giving birth. *Starting January 1, 2019, those with private health insurance will have access to reproductive health and related preventative services with no cost sharing. Federal changes to the Title X Program DO NOT impact the availability of family planning services in Oregon.*

**Oregon Contraceptive Care (CCARE):** CCARE offers free contraceptives, contraceptive counseling and annual exams to women and men who meet financial guidelines and eligibility requirements listed below:
